



### Guest information

Cape Conran Coastal Park is 415km east of Melbourne. To get there, take the Princes Highway M1 from Melbourne and turn off at Orbost to Cape Conran.

Located in a tranquil area of the campground, Wilderness Retreats at Cape Conran Coastal Park provide a “close to nature” experience of bush camping with all the conveniences of modern cabins.

The retreats sit on an innovative modular galvanised steel frame that does not require concrete footings. This is low impact accommodation that touches the earth lightly.

Wilderness Retreats are ideal for couples, but can sleep doubles or up to four people.

Each Wilderness Retreat at Cape Conran Coastal Reserve has:

- a timber deck and a lockable door
- a luxurious queen size bed with all linen, doonas and towels provided
- a trundle single bed (located under the queen size bed)
- a futon chair that converts to a single bed
- a small fridge with one complimentary bottle of drinking water
- lights inside and on the deck

A clean and well lit toilet and shower facility is close by.

Wilderness Retreat guests can make use of the well equipped, communal kitchen which contains:

- cutlery, crockery and cooking utensils
- stainless steel benches and sinks
- a gas cook top
- a full size fridge
- a microwave oven, toaster and tea and coffee making facilities

There is also a covered, tranquil BBQ area with seating for guests outside the kitchen. Guests just need to bring their own food and drinks. Please note that there is no drinking water at Cape Conran. Bottled water can be purchased from the Cape Conran park office. To make your experience enjoyable, we recommend you also bring warm clothes as there are no heaters, comfortable shoes, insect repellent, and a torch.

To preserve the experience for all guests, and allow wildlife to roam safely, no cars are allowed inside the Wilderness Retreat area. There are designated car parks for guests conveniently located near the retreats. A luggage trolley is available at the car park to assist with the short walk to your retreat. Please note that smoking is not permitted inside the Wilderness Retreats or kitchen.

### Services available

Cape Conran Coastal Park is located 18km from the small township of Marlo, which has a hotel and general store. There is also a jetty and boat ramp providing access to the Snowy River estuary system. East Gippsland offers guests a range of quality food and wine products, which can be purchased on the way and enjoyed during your stay.

### Activities

The Wilderness Retreats are set in an area home to rare and endangered animals, such as potoroos and bandicoots. There are a range of activities to be enjoyed at Cape Conran including diving, fishing, rock pooling and exploring kilometres of walking tracks through beautiful coastal forests. Surf lessons can be organised for groups. Park staff are happy to assist visitors explore and experience the environment. There are also a number of tour operators licensed by Parks Victoria that conduct a range of guided tours and activities in the park – from night walks to kayaking.
