



Guest information

Wilson's Promontory National Park is a 200km drive from Melbourne. To get there, take the South Gippsland Highway and turn right just past Meeniyah. Tidal River, where the main visitor facilities are, is 30km inside the park boundary.

Located in a tranquil area of the campground within easy walking distance to the beach, Wilderness Retreats at Tidal River provide a "close to nature" experience of bush camping with all the conveniences of modern cabins.

The retreats sit on an innovative modular galvanised steel frame that does not require concrete footings. This is low impact accommodation that touches the earth lightly.

Wilderness Retreats are ideal for couples, but can sleep doubles or an additional person.

Each Wilderness Retreat at Tidal River has:

- a luxurious queen size bed with all linen provided, with additional blankets and gas heating for those cooler nights
- a fully made up trundle single bed (located under the queen size bed)
- a private ensuite and a timber deck
- a small fridge and tea and coffee making facilities

Wilderness Retreat guests can make use of the exclusive communal kitchen accessible with the room key. The well equipped kitchen contains:

- cutlery, crockery and cooking utensils
- stainless steel benches and sinks
- a 4 burner gas cook top
- a full size fridge
- a microwave oven, toaster and additional tea and coffee making facilities

There is also a covered, tranquil BBQ area with seating for guests outside the kitchen. Guests just need to bring their own food and drinks. To make your experience enjoyable, we recommend you also bring warm clothes, comfortable shoes, insect repellent, and a torch.

To preserve the experience for all guests, and allow wildlife to roam safely, no cars are allowed inside the Wilderness Retreat area. There are designated car parks for guests conveniently located close to each retreat. Please note that smoking is not permitted inside the Wilderness Retreats or kitchen.

Services available

The Tidal River General Store is located within the campground and only a short walk from the Wilderness Retreats. The store includes a small supermarket and offers takeaway food, souvenirs, a newsagency and a small pharmacy range.

South Gippsland offers guests a range of quality food and wine products, which can be purchased on the way and enjoyed during your Wilderness Retreat stay. Activities

The Prom is framed by granite headlands, mountains, forests and fern gullies. Nature can easily be explored by foot, with a range of walks from short strolls to overnight hikes. The beautiful sandy beach along Tidal River at Norman Bay is within a short distance of the retreats, is safe for swimming and a delight to explore.

There are a range of outdoor activities to be enjoyed at the Prom. Park staff can provide advice to guests on things to do. There are also over 40 tour operators licensed by Parks Victoria that conduct a range of guided tours and activities in the park – from abseiling to yoga.
